The school year is quickly coming to its conclusion and much will be happening during these next few remaining weeks.

Easter break is Friday, April 15, through Monday, April 18. Classes will resume on Tuesday, April 19.

We will be administering the Iowa Assessment (achievement tests) to all students in Kindergarten through 12th grade. As a non-chartered, non-public school, we are required by the state to administer a nationally-normed test to our students each year, and all students are expected to take the tests.

Thursday, May 19, is an early dismissal day (11:30 a.m.) for all students in order to allow teachers time to finalize grades and prepare awards for Friday.

May 20, is the final day of school. The elementary awards program will begin at 8:45 a.m. The secondary awards program will begin at 10:00 a.m. Both ceremonies will be in the gym. Students will be dismissed at 11:30 a.m.

Senior graduation will be Friday, May 20, at 7:00 p.m. in the gym.

Report cards may be available for pick up on Friday, May 27, between 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. All accounts must be paid-in-full in order for us to release any student records including final report cards.
